(PROFESED) ORDER

Based upon plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and

Expedited Preliminary Injunction Hearing and the pleadings submitted therewith, the

Court makes the following Findings of Fact:

(i) That the potential harm to the plaintiffs is irreparable;

(ii) That defendants will not be harmed by the issuance of a Temporary

Restraining Order;

(iii) That a Temporary Restraining Order will not affect the interests of third

parties, including the public interest; and

(iv) That plaintiffs are likely to succeed at least partially on the merits of their claim that A.R.S. § 13-3506(1) is unconstitutional.
