A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to invasions of privacy, so as to prohibit the publication of certain information
- 3 relating to minors under certain circumstances; to provide for definitions; to provide for
- 4 penalties; to provide for venue; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 invasions of privacy, is amended by adding a new Part 3 to read as follows:

10 "Part 3

- 11 16-11-90.
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Child' means any individual who is under the age of 18 years.
- 14 (2) 'Personal identifying information' means a postal address, e-mail address, or
- 15 <u>telephone number.</u>
- 16 (3) 'Publish' means dissemination to any person.
- 17 (b) A person shall not knowingly publish, in print or electronically, a child's personal
- identifying information without the written consent of such child's parent or guardian. A
- 19 person convicted of violating this subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 20 (c) A person shall be subject to prosecution in this state pursuant to Code Section 17-2-1
- 21 <u>for any conduct made unlawful by this Code section which the person engages in while:</u>
- 22 (1) Either within or outside of this state if, by such conduct, the person commits a
- violation of this Code section which involves an individual who resides in this state; or

24 (2) Within this state if, by such conduct, the person commits a violation of this Code

- 25 <u>section which involves an individual who resides within or outside this state.</u>
- 26 (d) The provisions of subsection (b) of this Code section shall not apply to:
- 27 (1) The activities of law enforcement and prosecution agencies in the investigation and
- 28 <u>prosecution of criminal offenses; or</u>
- 29 (2) Legitimate medical, scientific, or educational activities.
- 30 (e) Any violation of this Code section shall constitute a separate offense and shall not
- 31 merge with any other crimes set forth in this title."

32 SECTION 2.

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
